09.09.2009 | Campus and Community The University of Dayton will remember the anniversary of the Sept. 11, 2001, attacks with the following events. All events are on Sept. 11, 2009.

- **8:46 a.m.:** Tolling of the Immaculate Conception Chapel bells for one minute to coincide with American Airlines Flight 11 hitting 1 World Trade Center.
- **9:03 a.m.:** Tolling of the Immaculate Conception Chapel bells for one minute to coincide with United Airlines Flight 175 hitting 2 World Trade Center.
- **9:37 a.m.:** Tolling of the Immaculate Conception Chapel bells for one minute to coincide with American Airlines Flight 77 hitting the Pentagon.
- **10:03 a.m.:** Tolling of the Immaculate Conception Chapel bells for one minute to coincide with United Airlines Flight 93 crashing in Pennsylvania.
- **9:30-10:20 a.m.: University of Dayton School of Law Faculty Lounge, 4th Floor:** The University of Dayton School of Law Student Bar Association is hosting a memorial and discussion. Law professor Dennis Greene will moderate the discussion during which students will reflect on that day and talk about how far the U.S. has come as a nation. Sister Mary Louise Foley, campus minister for the School of Law, will lead a prayer to remember the victims and heroes of Sept. 11, 2001.
- **12:05 p.m.:** The University of Dayton's regularly scheduled noon Mass. Every year, the campus community remembers those lost in the tragedies in New York, Pennsylvania and Washington, D.C., during a special Mass for Peace.
