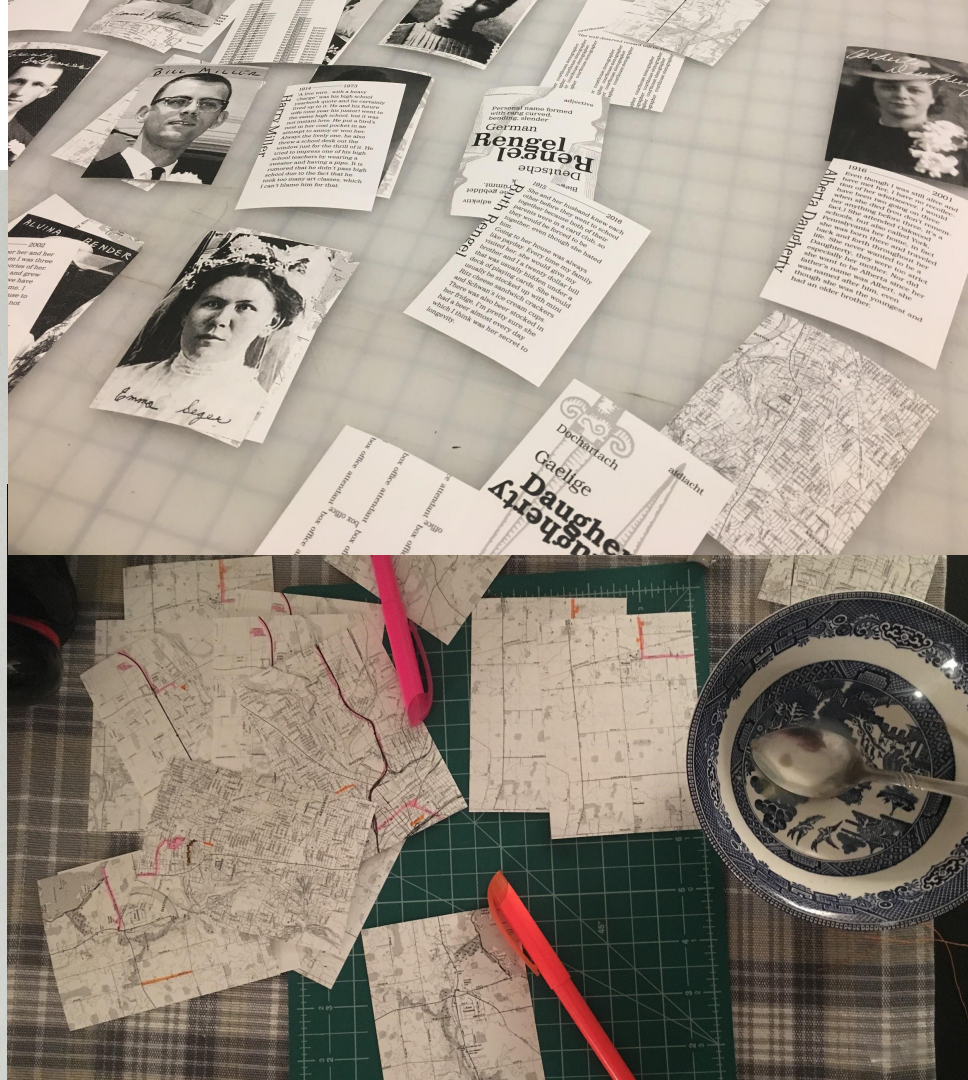

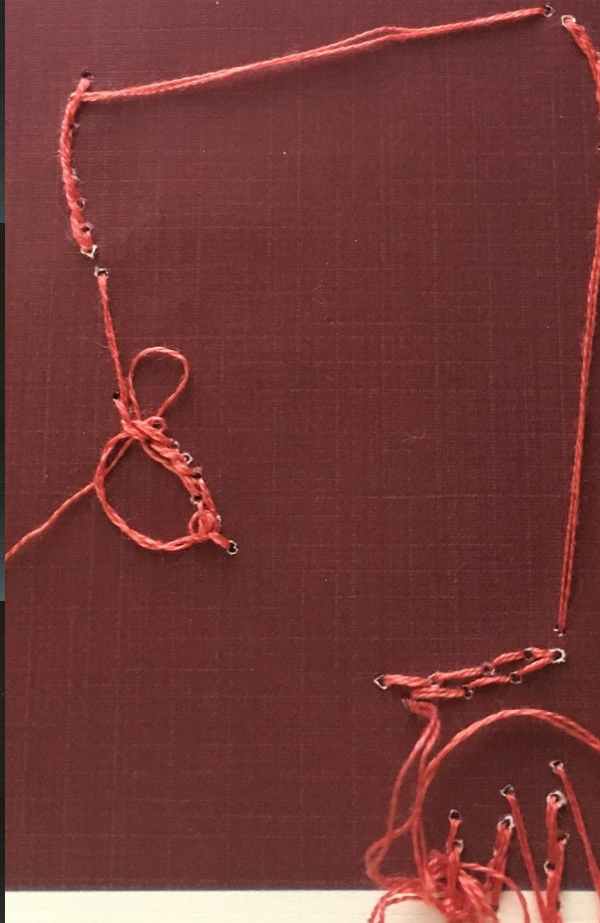
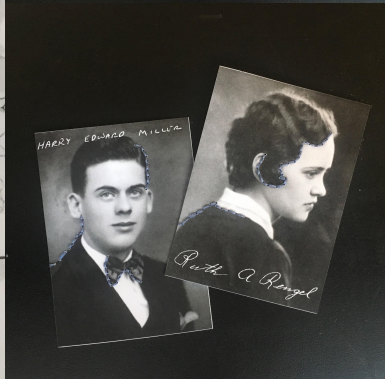

## CARD 1 — THE FACE CARD

Putting faces to a name helps to humanify people and realized that everyone was once like you. I chose portraits of my ancestors when they were in their 20s when they would be classified to be one of my peers or a relative age in my generation. I also chose to go as far back in my family to the last generation that I knew, for me that was to my great-grandparents. The colors embroidered on each card are specific to which societal generation they were a part of.

Red - The Lost Generation 1880-1900 - bloody red symbolizing the number of people killed in the First World War.

Gold - The Greatest Generation 1914-1930 - glittering gold representing those who grew up during the Great Depression and also fought in the Second World War during the golden age of America.

Blue - The Silent Generation 1930-1945 - muted blue illustrating those who hungered for safety and security after living through the Second World War and Depression in their early life.

Green - Baby Boomer 1946-1965 - money green portraying the economic prosperity and safety throughout their youth.

Pink - Millennials - 1980-2000 - rosy quartz pink defining the generation of a hopeful and fast-paced, changing technological society.

## CARD 2 — THE SURNAME CARD

Surnames originate from somewhere and were at one point normally related to a person's status, occupation, residency, or relation. For each of the last names, they are set in a typeface with ties to the country of the names' of origin.

German - Müller, Bender, Rengel, Seger, Eshman - set in Impressum

French - Cordonnier - set in Plantin

Old English - Sherman - set in Baskerville

Irish - Dougherty - set in Bookman

The definitions for each of the last names are in their country of origins language, showing how times have changed and a person's last name isn't their occupation.

## CARD 3 — THE OCCUPATION CARD

Day in and day out, people go to work and live most of their lives working. These cards show the repetitiveness of having a job and the connections formed between different jobs throughout a lifetime.

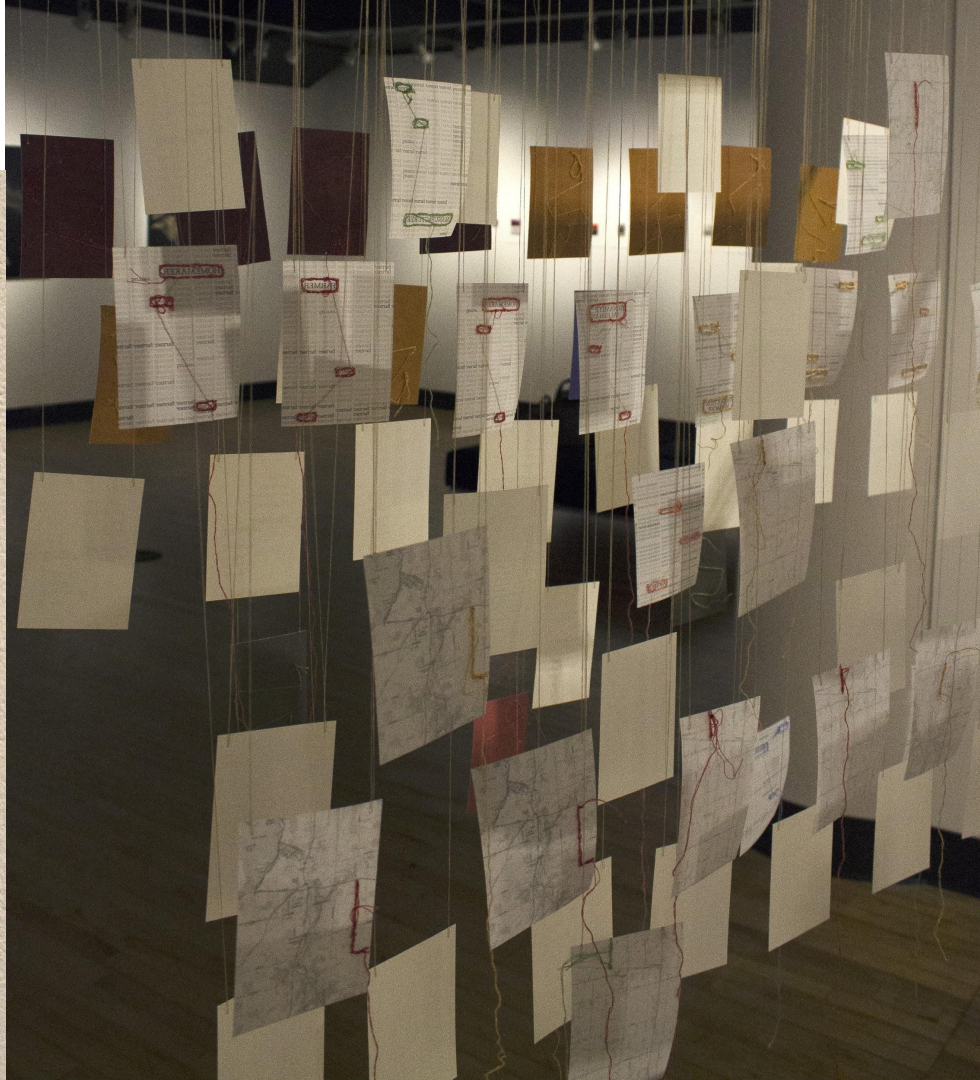
## CARD 4 — THE NARRATIVE CARD

Everyone's life is made up of stories that define who they are. These cards show their relation to me and when they were alive. The "em dash" between their birth and death dates represent their lifespan with each dash the equivalent point size of years they were alive.

The circles represent their birth order within their family and the gray circle outlines depicted a sibling that was a stillbirth or died as a baby. Each card has information and stories that I have gathered or remembered about them.

## CARD 5 — THE MAP CARD

Growing up, people know their home like the back of their hand. I mapped out the area where they grew up and spent a majority of their formative young adult years. I embroidered the road that they lived on. For Mary Eshman and Emma Seger, I am unsure where they grew up so I mapped out the location that they lived at after they were married since they were both in their early 20s.



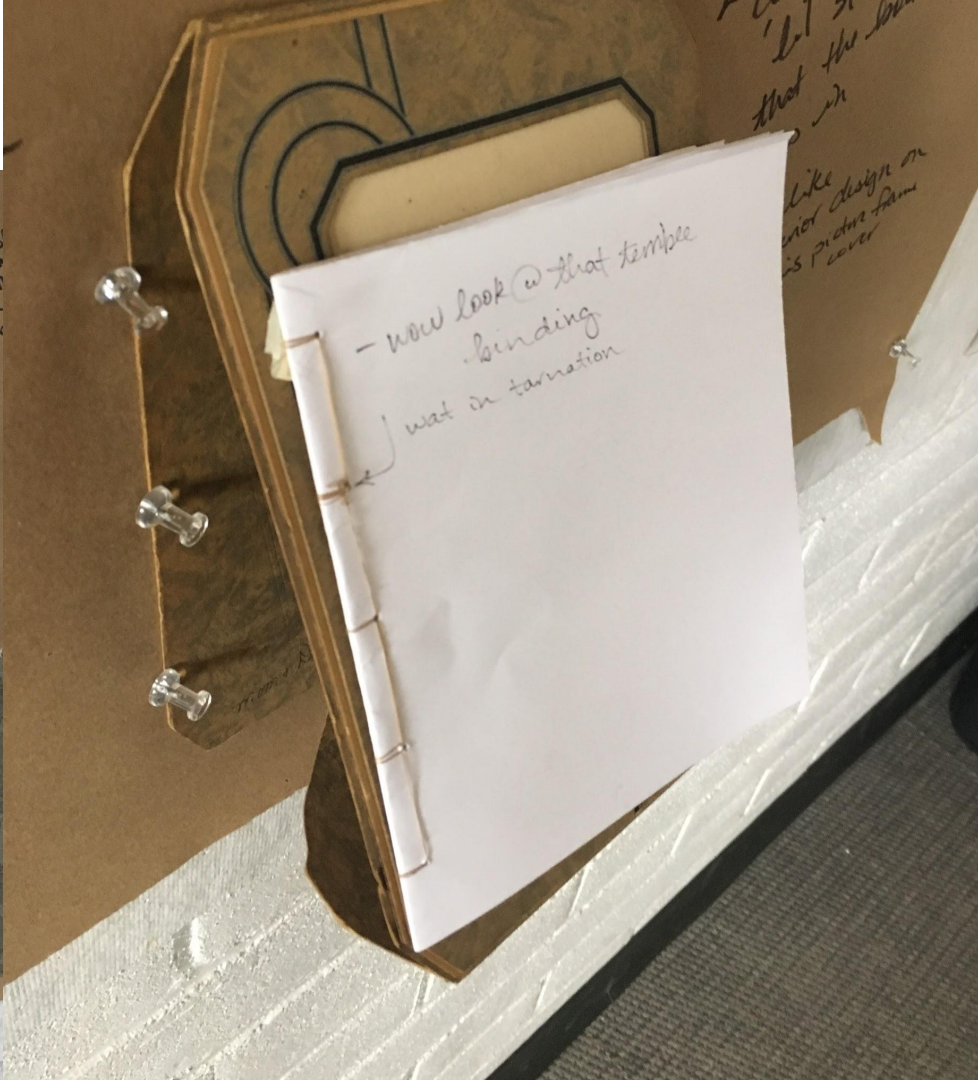

## THE INSPIRATION

Eachre has always been a part of my life and nearly every Miller Christmas party would be filled with rounds of Eachre. My mom and grandma (Miller Sherman) were part of the same Eachre card club and I would always sneak into the kitchen and meow to play the game so they wouldn't have to discover us as children. We learned and weren't disowned because the game has always been part of my family. My grandpa (Miller) remembers learning to play it when he was around 4 years old with his grandfather who would strictly tell him he "better start playing right, boy" when he would play the wrong card. My dad remembers learning playing it during night shift breaks at work. No matter when or where this game has is part of the fabric of my history.

When I first saw the word Eachre spelled out, I was baffled that it was spelled with an "E" and didn't start with a "U". I also thought that when people said they were going to go alone I thought that they mean "a loss" like they had to ask the dealer for more cards or money (this was at an age before I knew the rules). I misheard right/left "bower" as "bar" and was also shocked to see how it was actually spelled. With all of these confusing terms I heard growing up it's a wonder that I have always been interested in its origin and story.

## THE HISTORY

Eachre is a trick-taking card game played with 24 cards and typically in partners. The game is similar to the old French casino game, *Écarté*, which translated means "discarded". The game originated the poker card into modern card decks to act as the top trump or Bower. Bower originally came from the German word *Bauer*, which means "farmer". Eachre was brought to the United States by German immigrants and formed the Eachre belt through the states: Illinois, Indiana, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio, and had the power to determine the bop made the peasant the strongest card and had the power to determine the bop. Unlike the cut-throat mentality present in poker, Eachre is based on trusting your partner and making sacrifices in order to succeed as a team.

## THE RULES

There are many variants of rules depending on who is playing it and where it is played.

It's played with 4 people in two teams who are seated across from each other. You and your partner aim to get 10 points through scoring tricks. There are only 24 cards in a deck, all suits 9 through ace. Each player gets dealt five cards, the dealer has the extra 4 cards in the "kitty" and turns up the last card. When the last card is turned up, they go around the table if anyone wants the dealer to pick up the card and switch it with a card in their hand. If this happens then the card's suit is trump. The highest trump suit card will take winning tricks in rounds. If no body wants the dealer to pick up the card, then it is turned down and returns to the "kitty". It is when the suit for trump can be declared, but can not be the same suit that was turned down. If no trump is then declared by the dealer. Then the rounds begin with the person to the left of the dealer who lay down the first card and the other players have to follow suit. If they don't have the suit that started the round they have to play off suit and can trump the original card and win (the left bower.) The order of trump from highest to lowest is J, A, K, Q, 10, 9. If a person has a good hand they can opt to go alone which means they don't have their partner in the round and they have to take the tricks between their opponents.

Partners who take 3 or 4 tricks get 1 point  
Partners who make trump and win 5 tricks get 2 points  
Lone hand winning 3 or 4 tricks get 1 point  
Lone hand winning 5 tricks gets 4 points  
Partners or lone hands euchred, the opponents get 2 points
