Mrs. Robert (Mildred) Miles, Assistant Personnel Director of the Dayton City Public School System until her retirement this year, has been appointed an assistant professor of elementary education and coordinator of field experiences at the University of Dayton. The announcement was made by Dr. Simon Chavez, Chairman, Department of Elementary Education.

Mrs. Miles, who has a B.S. from Wittenberg University, has served in several administrative capacities in either the Dayton City or Montgomery County school systems over the past few years. Prior to her personnel position Mrs. Miles was teacher consultant in Dayton from 1958 to 1960. Previously she had been Director of Curricula and Instruction for Montgomery County from 1956 to 1958 and principal of the U.S. Grant Elementary School from 1953 to 1956.

She received her M.A. degree from Ohio State University and has done graduate work at Miami and Kent State Universities. She was born in St. Mary's Ohio.
