ENGINEERING CHAIR ESTABLISHED AT U.D.

Final settlement and distribution of bequests of the Estate of Frank M. Tait, founder of the Dayton Power & Light Company, resulted in a total gift of nearly \$400,000 to the University of Dayton. Mr. Tait died in 1962 and his wife in the following year.

Mr. Tait had been a long-time friend and benefactor of the University, both personally and through the great utility company which now services the greater part of the entire Miami Valley. His interest in the University was concentrated mainly on the School of Engineering, and in 1947, the Very Reverend George J. Renneker, President, conferred on him the honorary degree of Doctor of Science.

In further recognition of his generous considerations of the University's needs, the U.D. Administration announces the establishment now of the Frank Morrison Tait Chair of Engineering with \$350,000 of the recent bequest to be set aside as the endowment for the chair. (A chair is an endowed professorship. The income from the endowment fund being used to support in whole or in part the salary of a professor) The balance of the bequest, in excess of \$40,000, will be directed to the current C.H. Gosiger Memorial Health Center Fund.
