Kenneth B. Keating, former United States Senator and Representative from the State of New York, will speak at the University of Dayton Wednesday, March 9 at 12:30 p.m. in the John F. Kennedy Memorial Union.

Keating was elected to the Senate on November 4, 1958 after having severed 12 years in the House of Representatives. He was born in Lima, New York and graduated from the University of Rochester and Harvard Law School. Before entering Congress he was a practicing attorney in Rochester from 1923 to 1949.

While a member of the Senate, Keating was a member of the Committee on the Judiciary, the Committee on Commerce, the Committee on Aeronautical and Space Sciences and the Republican Policy Committee.

Mr. Keating's talk is being sponsored by the University of Dayton's Student Council. The talk is open to the public and there is no admission charge.
