Three local University of Dayton alumni, doctor George J. Rau, lawyer Hugh Wall and engineer Donald Ruhl, were recipients last night of the three annual Alumni Awards of the Montgomery County Chapter, National Alumni Association of UD. The presentations were made at the Alumni Homecoming Dinner in the John F. Kennedy Memorial Union.

Mr. Wall received the Civic Achievement Award for demonstrating a lively interest in the University of Dayton and the community, and their development. Dr. Rau received the Professional Achievement Award for his efforts in the community and for the long-time service to University's athletic department.

Mr. Ruhl was given the award for Outstanding Chapter Service to the Montgomery Chapter over the past four and a half years.

Mr. Wall, in the citation, was praised for his long time service to the University and many community clubs and projects. He was cited for his efforts with UD's Committee on Wills, Bequests, Annuities and Insurance, the Executive Committee of the Ohio Bar Association, the Catholic High School Drive and the National Conference of Christians and Jews. He is a partner in the law firm of Coolidge, Wall & Wood.

Mr. Ruhl, Chief Equipment Engineer at Standard Register Company, has served as an officer in the Montgomery Chapter for the past 4 1/2 years. He is presently a member of the Board of Directors but served as vice president and president in previous years. He has instituted many of the projects for University and community service within the chapter recently.

Dr. Rau, who is still the team physician for the UD basketball program, dropped the football assignment this fall after 16 years. His citation noted the long hours he has devoted to injured and ill athletes at the University of Dayton and his devotion to the program despite personal illness in recent years. Dr. Rau, at one time, was Chief of Staff at St. Elizabeth's Hospital.
