DAYTON, Ohio, November 29, 1966 --- Jerome Westendorf, '43 and former University of Dayton football player, has been elected President of that University's National Alumni Association, Bro. Elmer C. Lackner, Vice President for Alumni Relations, announced today. He replaces Mr. Paul Heckman, '38. Both men are Daytonians. Mr. Westendorf, a Certified Public Accountant, lives at 2509 Salem Avenue.

Mr. James Gilvary, '51, was elected vice president and Mr. Barth Snyder, '31, treasurer. Mr. Gilvary is a lawyer and Mr. Snyder is Chairman of UD's Business Management Department in the School of Business Administration. Mr. Gilvary lives at 941 Malone and Mr. Snyder at 3270 Bellbrook-Fairfield Road, Bellbrook.

Mary Shay remains as alumni secretary working in the University's Department of Public Relations, Alumni and Development. All are members of the Board of Directors.
