Anderson, internationally-known Tectono Physicist from the Lamont Geology Laboratories, Columbia University, will give a public lecture tomorrow in the University of Dayton's Sherman Hall at 4 P.M. The lecture, which will be in room 114, is entitled "The Composition of the Upper Mantle and Its Connection with the Physical Properties of the Planet Earth".

Dr. Anderson received his three degrees, B.S., M.S., and Ph.D. from the University of Utah in 1948, 1949 and 1951 respectively. His talk is cosponsored by UD's Departments of Physics and Geology.
