The University of Dayton will share in the grant made to the Ohio Foundation of Independent Colleges, Inc. by the S&H Foundation, Inc. The grant, part of a \$37,000 gift to the 39 State Associations of Privately Supported Colleges and Universities across the country, was presented to Herman L. Wiler, Assistant Director of the Ohio Foundation of Independent Colleges by Richard J. Quill, Sales Representative for The Sperry and Hutchinson Company. The company, distributor of S&H Green Stamps, sponsors the S&H Foundation.

The grant is the sixth made by S&H to the Independent College Funds of America. It is part of the S&H Foundation's regular program of Aid to Education which also includes visiting lectureship grants, national scholarships, special education grants, 4-H scholarships, matching contributions, and scholarships for children of S&H employees.
