DAYTON, Ohio, April 10, 1967 --- The Dayton Civic Ballet will be the highlight of a "Festival of Arts Day" on April 15 in the John F. Kennedy Memorial Union, University of Dayton. Artists in Action and two exhibits will complete the day-long program.

The Civic Ballet will give two performances in the Little Theater. The first show will begin at 2 P.M. and the second at 8:30 P.M. A Punch Hour will follow the afternoon performance while a Champagne Hour will precede the evening show. These are included in the price of the tickets.

The Artists in Action will be conducted in the afternoon and early evening on the Rooftop Terrace. The artists from the University and the Dayton Art Institute will be working on the Terrace during that period.

The Capezio Theatrical Costumes exhibit will be in the Art Gallery and the Mrs. Helen Stamas' Student Fashion Illustrations will be hung in the Torch Lounge. The Capezio showing consists of 13 costumes from Broadway musical shows from 1912 to the present.
