DAYTON, Ohio, February 21, 1968 --- The University of Dayton will present a local soprano as guest artist for the Tuesday evening, March 12, Cameo Concert program. The 8:15 p.m. recital by Sally Taubenheim will include works of Purcell, Vivaldi, Schubert, and Chausson. Her accompanist will be Wilma Meckstroth. The program, held in Boll Theater of the Kennedy Union, is free and open to the public.

Mrs. Taubenheim majored in voice at Baldwin-Wallace College where she was a student of Buron Garlinghouse. She did Master's work in voice at the University of Illinois, during which time she coached with Paul Ulanowsky.

Since coming to Dayton, she has appeared as guest soloist with the Dayton Philharmonic Orchestra, Wright State University Chorus and Orchestra, Scottish Rite Choir, Temple Israel, and is a soloist at Westminster Presbyterian Church.

Before moving to Dayton, Mrs. Taubenheim appeared as Sister Angelica in Puccini's "Sister Angelica," and as the heroine in the musical comedy "Leave It To Jane" at Wabash College.

A member of Mu Phi Epsilon, National Professional Music Sorority, she has served on the board of the Dayton Music Club, and is a performing member of the Dayton Chamber Music Society.
