DAYTON, Ohio, March 18, 1968 --- Dr. Ellis Joseph, Chairman, Department of Secondary Education at the University of Dayton, will be the speaker Thursday night, March 21, in the 1968 UD Intellectual Frontiers Series. The topic, which will be the fourth in a five-lecture series, is "Environments, Growth, Intelligence and Empathy: Hypotheses and Implications for the Helping Professions."

Dr. Joseph, who is a frequent lecturer in Ohio, will discuss the various factors which prompt individuals to enter such professions as teaching, coaching, social work, clergy and medicine. Dr. Joseph has made an extensive survey on this subject.

Dr. Joseph, who has been with UD since 1961, is an authority on the philosophy of education and is the author of Jacques Maritain on Humanism and Education. He has three degrees from the University of Notre Dame, including his doctorate.
