DAYTON, Ohio, April 30, 1968 --- The Central Association of College and University Business Officers will hold their 56th Annual Meeting in Dayton, May 2-4, 1968. The Thursday and Friday meetings will take place in the Kennedy Union at the University of Dayton.

Approximately 300 members from the 18 states in the region covered by the Central Association are expected to attend the meeting. The host chairman for the event is Mr. Gerald W. VonderBrink, Comptroller at the University of Dayton, assisted by Mr. Robert V. Rotterman of the UD Business Office.

The program theme for the meeting is "Utilization of Resources Available to Colleges and Universities." Registration will open on Thursday morning at the Kennedy Union, with the opening session being conducted by Mr. Keith L. Nitcher of the University of Kansas, President of the Association. Topics to be covered the first day include: "Resources from the Student Sector," featuring the President of the Student Government at Purdue University; "Foundation Support and Requirements," by Dr. Manning M. Patillo, Director of the Foundation Library Center; "Internal Resources from the Management Sector" and "Internal Resources from the Budgeting Sector."

On Friday morning, the Ohio Association of College and University Business Officers will conduct a separate business meeting. Included among the reports to be presented will be one by Dr. Charles J. Armstrong, President of the Dayton-Miami Valley Consortium, who will discuss computer centralization.

Among the speakers for the second day of the meeting are Dr. John D. Millett, Chancellor, Ohio Board of Regents, who will speak on "Resources from the State Government Sector," and Mr. Joseph Shutt, Vice President for Corporate Relations, Council for Financial Aid to Education on "Resources from the Corporate Sector." The other topics for the day are: "Resources from the Federal Sector," "Human Resources Sector," and "Endowment Investment-Challenge and Opportunity."

The closing sessions and business meeting will be held Saturday morning at the Statler Hilton Inn. Dr. Peggy Heim, staff economist of the American Association of University Professors, will speak at this meeting on the subject of Faculty Compensation and its relationship to a university budget.
