DAYTON, Ohio, May 7, 1968 --- Dr. Manfred Kochen, a leading authority of information science from the University of Michigan, will be the guest speaker at a dinner-meeting of the Southern Ohio Chapter of the American Society for Information Science in the University of Dayton's Kennedy Union. The dinner will start at 6:45 p.m.

Dr. Kochen's lecture, entitled "Stability in the Growth of Knowledge," will outline some of the concepts, methods, and problems of two developments which can be anticipated during the next few decades; (1) computer-aided bibliographic control and, (2) computer aids to individual decision-making. Dr. Kochen will indicate how these two subjects will fit into academic disciplines.
