DAYTON, Ohio, September 16, 1968 --- Dr. Carl R. Jantzen, noted anthropologist from Miami University in Oxford, will be a guest lecturer at the University of Dayton on Thursday, September 26, at 7:30 P.M. Dr. Jantzen will speak on "The Old Colony Mennonites of Mexico." Lecture is free and open to the public. It will be held in room 211 of the University's Kennedy Union.

Dr. Jantzen, who holds degrees from Bethel College, Kansas; and Michigan State University, has written and lectured extensively on anthropology. His research has taken him to Germany, Austria, Iraq, Mexico, and the United States and has included the Iraqi Kurds, Old Order of Amish of Indiana and Pennsylvania, Old Colony Mennonites of Mexico, Middle East as a cultural area and religion and socioreligious groups.

He is a Fellow of the American Anthropological Association and a member of the Central States Anthropological Society, Society for Applied Anthropology and The American Sociological Association. He also has served as an archeologist in Michigan.
