DAYTON, Ohio, June 19, 1969 --- Dr. Carl Bracy, executive secretary of the Ohio Foundation of Independent Colleges in Columbus, presented a check for \$132,164.94 today (Thursday, June 19) to the Rev. Raymond A. Roesch, S.M., University of Dayton President, for UD's share of the 1968-69 OFIC fund-raising campaign.

The \$132,164.94, largest single contribution ever received by UD, brought to \$1,091,876.94 the amount the University has received from OFIC in its 12 years as a member of the organization. OFIC embraces 35 universities and colleges throughout Ohio.

OFIC's 1968-69 statewide campaign realized \$1,672,490, a record result. Since its creation in 1951, the organization has raised \$18,034,079 from the Ohio business and industrial community.
