DAYTON, Ohio, July 6, 1970 --- The graduate programs for the preparation of elementary and secondary teachers, principals and guidance counselors in the School of Education at the University of Dayton have been given full accreditation, Mr. Rolf W. Larson, Director of the National Council for Accreditation of Teacher Education, has informed Dr. Joseph Panzer, S.M., Dean, School of Education.

The accreditation, approved after a full-scale review last November, comes on the 10th anniversary of graduate work at the University of Dayton.

In announcing the accreditation, Mr. Rolf said that the Council was particularly impressed with the obvious growth and vitality of the programs reviewed and praised the professorial and administrative staff for their interest and competency.
