DAYTON, Ohio, September 1, 1970 --- "Foundation in Theology," a 16-week series during the next five months, will be presented by the Department of Theological Studies and the Religion In Life Series at the University of Dayton, starting Thursday, September 3. The program, divided into four quarters with each unit self-contained, will be conducted in Miriam Hall, Room 107, from 8 to 10 p.m. each Thursday, through January 14, 1971.

The program, under the direction of Dr. William P. Anderson, Department of Theological Studies, is an effort to acquaint interested laymen, clergy and religious educators with some of the critical contemporary theological issues. The series is of an ecumenical nature.

Dr. Anderson, who is an ordained Presbyterian minister, says that interested persons can enroll in individual quarters at \$3. per quarter, or for the whole program at \$10. Registration can be made by calling 229-4339, or 229-4321.

First Quarter: The Problem of Faith and Doubt, Dr. Michael Barnes, Assistant Professor of Theology, University of Dayton, September 3, 10, 17, and 24.

Second Quarter: The Question of Jesus Today, Rev. Charles Brady, S.M., Associate Professor of Theology, University of Dayton, October 1, 8, 15, 22.

Third Quarter: Contemporary Issues in Ethics and Doctrine, Dr. Richard Boulet, Associate Professor of Theology, University of Dayton, October 29, November 5, 12, 19.

Fourth Quarter: Catechetics, Bro. Leo Murray, S.M., Assistant Professor of Theology, University of Dayton, December 3, 10, January 7, 14.
