DAYTON, Ohio, February 1, 1971 --- Research demonstrations and their application to the classroom, including those in environmental quality, will highlight the joint Open House of the Departments of Biology and Physics at the University of Dayton this Sunday, February 7, 1971. The program will run from 2 to 5 p.m. in the Sherman Hall of Science, beginning in room 113.

Visitors will have the opportunity to talk to and visit the University's Computer Center, see typical laboratory experiments for freshman science students and advanced physics, biology and pre-medical students.

In addition they will have an opportunity to talk with faculty and students about college guidance, careers in science and medicine and student life on a university campus. They will also be able to discuss college finances with Mr. James Hoover, Director of the University's Student Aid and Scholarship Office.

Tours will be made through the physics research labs in laser optics, nuclear physics, environmental research, polymer physics, magnetic properties and cryogenics, and the biology facilities in electron microscopy, radiation biology, population and environmental research, animal physiology, molecular genetics, microbiology and medical technology.

Films and slides on many interesting science subjects will be shown.
