DAYTON, Ohio, February 1, 1971 --- Fifty-four men and women representing the Board of Trustees, faculty, students, administration, and alumni of the University of Dayton, and the Dayton community have been named to the six standing committees of the University of Dayton's new Board of Trustees, H. Talbott Mead, Chairman of the UD Board and President of the Mead Investment Company, announced today.

Mr. Mead also announced the appointment of chairmen of the committees. All are members of the University's new Board which was officially created last November 13. The committees and chairmen are:

Matters for the attention of a committee shall be referred to the appropriate committee by the Chairman of the Board, the President of the University, or may be originated within the committee in its area of activity.

Twenty-two of the 24 Board members are serving on committees. Other groups represented are eight undergraduate and two graduate student, eleven faculty, seven alumni and four community. Mr. Mead and Rev. Raymond Roesch, S.M., University President, are ex-officio members of all committees.
