DAYTON, Ohio, February 19, 1971 --- The University of Dayton has received two gifts from the International Business Machines Corporation for the school's three-year New Horizons fund-raising program. The corporation, through its branch manager Mr. J. S. DeBlasi, presented checks for \$10,000 as the second installment on its \$25,000 pledge to the recently-opened library and \$825 representing the company's Matching Grants Program.

In the latter grant, IBM matches gifts given by employees to their alma maters. The University has received \$9,217 in this manner from IBM since 1960.

The corporation's \$25,000 pledge is through its commitment to community involvement program. Final installment will be awarded to the University in early 1972 bringing IBM's gifts to UD to \$54,217.
