DAYTON, Ohio, February 23, 1971 --- Thousands of University of Dayton alumni throughout the world will attend Mass and Communion this Sunday, February 28, as part of the National Alumni Association's ninth annual International Communion Sunday. Theme of the celebration is "Peace in the World".

Rev. William Ferree, S.M., UD '28, Provincial of the Society of Mary's Cincinnati Province, is serving as Honorary International chairman of the event and will celebrate Mass in the University's Immaculate Conception Chapel with Greater Dayton Chapter members. Mass is at 10 A.M. after which breakfast will follow in the Kennedy Union Ballroom. Mrs. Virginia Evers, '68, a fourth grade teacher at St. Anthony's School, is chairman of the local celebration.

Father Ferree, in his message to alumni throughout the world, urged that Catholics attend in groups or singly, and invited non-Catholics to attend the Church of their choice, all to pray for "Peace in the World."

Alumni in Africa, Europe, South America, Mexico and fifteen locations in the United States from San Francisco to Florida will participate in the celebration.
