DAYTON, OHIO, September 14, 1971 --- Dr. John Murray, Professor of Law at the University of Pittsburgh, will conduct two informative sessions concerning the "Legal Aspects of Purchasing" at the University of Dayton in cooperation with the Purchasing Management of Dayton. The topics will include the Robinson-Patman Act, Terms and Conditions of Purchasing, and an analysis of your forms and contracts. Seminar will be held on Friday and Saturday, October 15 and 16.

Dr. Murray holds a B.S. at LaSalle College, 1955, J.D. from Catholic University of America, 1958, and an S.J.D. from the University of Wisconsin. He received a scholarship to Catholic University of America, and a Fellowship from the University of Wisconsin. He was Editor of the Law Review, Catholic University of America. He is a member of the Order of the Coif. Dr. Murray also holds a double appointment at the University of Pittsburgh, that of a Professor of Law, and a Professor in the Graduate School of Business. He has written several books and many articles on law and commercial law. He is a consultant to law firms and business men and groups, both in Pittsburgh and other areas of the country. He has also conducted a symposia on Legal Principals for Purchasing Agents for the Pittsburgh Purchasing Institute for the past several years.

The sessions will be held on Friday from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m., and on Saturday from 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. The talks will be in the Kennedy Union, Room 310. Registration fee will be \$15.00.
