DAYTON, Ohio, March 20, 1972 --- Dr. William Huctor, Vice President and leading economist of the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland, will participate in the American Economics Association and National Science Academy's Visiting Scientists Program at the University of Dayton this Friday, March 24. Dr. Huctor, who will appear under the sponsorship of UD's Economics Department, will conduct four different sessions, starting at 9:15 A.M. and closing at 4:30 P.M.

The program will begin in the Kennedy Union, room 313, with informal talks with students and faculty members. At 11 A.M. he will give a lecture, "Competition in the Banking Industry," room 210 of Chaminade Hall.

Following a luncheon break, the program will continue at 1:30 P.M. with another informal talk session with students and faculty. The final phase of the program, a seminar entitled, "The Economy - Problems to Policy Makers," will start at 3 P.M. in Miriam Hall, room 106, and conclude at 4:30 P.M.
