DAYTON, Ohio, June 9, 1972 --- Less than two weeks remain for prospective teachers who plan to take the National Teacher Examinations at the University of Dayton on July 15, 1972, to submit their registrations for these tests to Educational Testing Service, Princeton, New Jersey, Joseph E. White, Assistant Dean of Education announced today. Registrations for the examinations must be forwarded so as to reach the Princeton Office not later than June 22.

Bulletins of Information describing registration procedures and containing Registration Forms may be obtained from the School of Education, University of Dayton or directly from the National Teacher Examinations, Educational Testing Service, Box 911, Princeton, New Jersey, 08540.

At the one-day test session a candidate may take the Common Examinations, which include tests in Professional Education and General Education, and one of the twenty-two Teaching Area Examinations which are designed to evaluate his understanding of the subject matter and methods applicable to the area he may be assigned to teach.

Each candidate will receive an Admissions Ticket advising him of the exact location of the center to which he should report. Candidates for the Common Examinations will report at 8:30 A.M. on July 15, and should finish at approximately 12:30 P.M. The Teaching Area Examinations will begin at 1:30 P.M. and should finish at approximately 4:15 P.M., according to the time schedule for these examinations which has been set up by Educational Testing Service.
