DAYTON, Ohio, June 9, 1972 --- John B. Dunn, an honor student at the University of Dayton and son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph E. Dunn, 5 Titusville Heights, Poughkeepsie, has been elected President of the newly-formed Pi Sigma Alpha, Dayton Chapter of the Political Science National Honor Society. Mr. Dunn, who carries a 3.3 academic average out of a possible 4.0 in his major, will serve as President during the 1972-73 school year at the University of Dayton. His junior year average, just completed, was 3.8.

Mr. Dunn, who will be serving his second year as the Assistant Speaker of Student Congress at UD, is a member of the University President's Planning Council. Carrying the John F. Kennedy Memorial Upperclass Scholarship at UD, Mr. Dunn has been very active with the University Vice President, Reverend George B. Barrett, in the University's Planning for the Seventies program which is serving to update the entire UD community.

Mr. Dunn, who plans to attend law school, is a member of Delta Upsilon, national social fraternity; has played two years on the baseball team and has been a member of the Flyer News staff, student newspaper for two years.
