DAYTON, Ohio, October 18, 1972 --- "Celebrations Around the World" is the theme for the annual International Tea, sponsored by the University of Dayton's International Club, on Sunday, October 22, 4 to 6 p.m. in the Kennedy Union Ballroom.

A social hour, highlighting teas, beverages and pastries from around the world, will be followed by an hour of international entertainment. About thirty countries will be represented. The tea is free and open to the public.

Singing, dancing, folk stories, and musical instruments will be provided by members of the International Club and their guests, and by church groups and cooperating international organizations. There'll be French and Spanish singing and guitar playing. Irish and Slavic dances, and dances from Panama and India, will be performed. A student will demonstrate the koto, the ancient traditional Japanese string instrument. And much more is promised.

Pastries will be supplied by local families and friends of the club, and by local and nationality bakeries.

Native costumes will be worn by many foreign students and guests. The Ballroom will be decorated with displays, flags, and posters of the different countries, to add to the atmosphere.

Everyone in the Dayton area is invited to come and share in the festivities. This year, up to a thousand guests are expected.

The International Club numbers about a hundred members, three-fourths of which are foreign students. Others include American students who have traveled abroad, or who are interested in a foreign country. The Club always welcomes new members.
