DAYTON, Ohio, January 18, 1972 --- The 20-piece Parkhills High School jazz band and the Meadowdale band have been added to the University of Dayton's "Festival of Jazz Bands" this Sunday in the Kennedy Union Ballroom from 2 p.m. to 9 p.m. The Parkhills band is the sixth swing group in the seven-hour music marathon which is sponsored by the Music Division of the Performing and Visual Arts Department.

The Parkhills musicians, who will fill the 7 to 8 p.m. slot, will play a mixture of contemporary rock, and the jazz and swing styles of Stan Kenton and Duke Ellington. Meadowdale will play between 5 and 6 p.m.
