DAYTON, Ohio, March 19, 1982 -- "Women Trusting Women" will be the subject discussed by Sister Dorothy Bock, S.S.S.F. on March 30 at the University of Dayton. The talk will be held in O'Leary Auditorium at 7:30 p.m.

Bock is program director and co-founder of Womanspace Center, a women's development center in Rockford, Illinois. The Center provides counseling, seminars, classes, interdenominational retreats, and other services for women. Bock's goal is to develop a program which helps women "grow, psychologically, spiritually and culturally."

Her talk will focus on why women have not always trusted each other, and she will lend advice on why women should work together toward common goals.

Following her talk a panel of UD faculty members will comment. The panel includes Marsha Jacobson (psychology), Patricia Johnson (philosophy), Joann Fiehler (fine arts), and Sister Judith Martin (religious studies).

The talk is free and open to the public.
