STUDENTS INVITED TO PARTICIPATE
IN UD MODEL UN CONFERENCE

DAYTON, Ohio, September 2, 1982 -- The University of Dayton Model United Nations Club will sponsor its fourth annual Model United Nations Conference for high school students on Thursday, November 18. The conference will take place in the Kennedy Memorial Union on the University of Dayton campus.

High school students will represent delegations from countries of varying sizes and cultural, political and economic structures. By participating in debates and caucuses and writing resolutions students will develop an understanding of diplomacy and its importance in the workings of the United Nations. The International Court of Justice; the Security Council; Political/Security Committee; Social, Humanitarian, and Cultural Committee; Ad Hoc Committee on International Terrorism; and the Commission on Narcotic Drugs are the committees which will be simulated.
