ART ON THE UD LIBRARY LAWN

DAYTON, Ohio, September 7, 1982 -- On Saturday and Sunday, September 18 and 19 over 30 area artists will gather on the University of Dayton Roesch Library lawn to display their wares. The Library Lawn Artsorama will be held each day from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. Admission is free.

This two-day show will feature fine arts, crafts, music, dance, poetry, mime and the sale of refreshments. Watercolors, pottery, calligraphy, woodcarving, casted jewelry, wire sculpture, and lapidary are some of the art forms to be displayed.

The Artsorama, the oldest outdoor show in southwest Ohio, is sponsored by the University of Dayton in cooperation with the Dayton Society of Painters and Sculptors.
