FORUM ON U.S.-SOVIET RELATIONS AT UD SUNDAY

DAYTON, Ohio, November 10, 1982 -- Five officials from the Soviet Union will be at the University of Dayton on Sunday, November 14, 1982 to discuss U.S. and Soviet relations. The forum will be held in the West Ballroom of Kennedy Union at 3 p.m.

The visiting Soviet officials are Oleg Voiekov, the program director of the Committee on Youth Organizations (CYO); Gennady Varikuta, the vice-chairman of the CYO; Alexander Kondgakov, a CYO member; Igor Malashenko, from the Institute of U.S.A. and Canada Studies; and Valadimir Baranovski who is representing the Institute of the World Economy. This forum will address issues including the Soviet press, international economics, the future directions of the Communist Party, and life in the Soviet Union.

The event is sponsored by the U.S.A.-U.S.S.R. Citizens Dialogue and some faculty members of the University of Dayton College of Arts and Sciences. The forum is free and open to the public.
