DANCE ENSEMBLE PERFORMS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF DAYTON

DAYTON, Ohio, November 23, 1982 -- The University of Dayton Dance Ensemble will present a concert of works encompassing modern dance and modern jazz styles on Friday, December 3 and Saturday, December 4 at 8 p.m. in Boll Theatre. Admission is free.

In addition to six UD students, Norma Estes, formerly with the Dayton Ballet, and Beth Helmig, a teacher at the John Rodriguez School of Ballet, will perform. The group is directed by Dian Gutridge and choreographed by Jeni Engle, an instructor in the UD theatre division, and Jim Neirinck, an artist who has presented his work in New York and in Europe this past year.

Highlights of the concert are Engel's "Do Da Day," in which the dancers wear portable audio synthesizers and Gutridge's "Summerthree," a romantic piece set to the music of Samuel Barber. Neirinck will offer a solo to music by Klaus Nomi.
