"CHRISTMAS THROUGH THE YEARS:
A FAMILY CELEBRATION" AT UD

DAYTON, Ohio, November 23, 1982 -- The University of Dayton community will gather together on Wednesday, December 8, to begin the holiday season in a special way. This year's gathering, "Christmas Through The Years: A Family Celebration," is the nineteenth Christmas on Campus celebration. Christmas on Campus allows young and old alike to enjoy the magic of the Christmas season.

Activities begin at 6:30 p.m. with the re-enactment of the Nativity scene and the lighting of the Christmas tree in the Kennedy Union Plaza. The Kennedy Union, where most of the activities take place, becomes a Christmas wonderland. UD students "adopt" Dayton area children and senior citizens for the evening.

The entertainment, which continues until 9:30 p.m., includes a carnival, a petting zoo, model train displays, cartoons, mime, synchronized swimming, a brass choir, singing and dancing groups, a kid's theatre production, and much more. At 8:30 p.m., the University Choir will perform in the UD Chapel. At 10 p.m. the University community will gather together in the UD Fieldhouse to celebrate Mass.
