UD TO HOST INVESTMENT & FINANCIAL PLANNING EXPO

DAYTON, Ohio, December 7, 1982 -- The University of Dayton School of Business Administration presents the First Annual Investments and Financial Planning Exposition on Saturday, January 15 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wall Street Week panelists, Gail M. Dudak and Robert J. Nurock will highlight the day's activities with separate keynote addresses. Representatives from 30 area financial institutions and investment firms will be on hand to discuss personal investments and financial planning.

According to Jay F. Richmond, director of UD's School of Business Administration Office of Continuing Education and coordinator of the conference, the Expo is designed to provide consumers with a financial services shopping center. "We hope to assist in the decision-making process -- to help those interested in investing to understand the many opportunities available to them."

There will be exhibits, as well as special financial seminars on minimizing taxes, estate planning, stocks and bonds investment, portfolio strategies, and other investment areas. The workshops will be conducted by the faculty of the UD School of Business Administration.

The day-long event is being held at the Dayton Convention Center. The advanced registration fee for the entire conference, including the keynote addresses, workshops, and exhibitions, is \$20. An admission fee of \$5 will be charged for those wishing only to visit the exhibits.
