TAIWAN PIANIST TO PERFORM AT UD

DAYTON, Ohio, December 28, 1982 -- A piano recital will be given by Gwan-Ying Wu at the University of Dayton Chapel on January 12 at 8 p.m.

A native of Taiwan, Wu began her musical studies at the age of six. She gave her first concert at the age of ten, and at thirteen performed Mozart Piano Concerto K. 488 with the Kuang-Jen Orchestra.

In 1975, she came to the United States, and entered the San Francisco Conservatory of Music in the Pre-College Division. In 1977, she was offered a special award to further her musical training at the Mannes College of Music in New York City. Two years later, she continued her studies at the Juilliard School as a scholarship student of Madame Nadia Reisenberg.

Currently she holds both a Bachelor of Music degree and a Master of Music degree from the Juilliard School. Last March Wu was the winner of Artists International Competition in New York. She has also appeared as soloist and recitalist throughout the Orient and on the east coast of the U.S. and will be giving her debut on January 23 at the Carnegie Recital Hall.

At UD, she will perform pieces by Chopin, Rachmaninoff, and Beethoven. The recital is free and open to the public.
