UD LAW STUDENTS OFFER
FREE TAX ASSISTANCE

DAYTON, Ohio, February 10, 1983 -- For the third year the University of Dayton School of Law will conduct a Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program through April 14. The program is a free income tax service for those with incomes less than \$30,000 filing single returns and less than \$50,000 filling joint returns. The program is open to anyone who needs assistance. In addition, tax-related questions will be answered and tax return forms are available.

VITA is run by a staff of approximately 35 UD law students who attended a two-day course and passed an exam. The program is certified by the Internal Revenue Service.

This free tax service is available from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday through Thursday and from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday. Appointments are not necessary. The VITA office is located at 1015 Zehler Avenue, near the UD Roesch Library. For more information, call 229-2544 or 229-2323.
