DAYTON, Ohio, February 14, 1983 -- The work of three area artists will be on display in the University of Dayton Kennedy Union Art Gallery through February 28. The three artists are Bing Davis from Central State University, James Padgett from Wilberforce University, and Curtis Barnes from Sinclair Community College.

Davis will exhibit works in oils, pastels, charcoal, and clay pottery. Padgett's work will include oils, acrylics, charcoal and pencil sketches and Barnes' work is done in oils.
