TWO UD ARTS SERIES EVENTS
SCHEDULED FOR MARCH

DAYTON, Ohio, February 28, 1983 -- The Flemish musician, Tinctoris, in 1477, uttered a sentiment which each generation believes to be its own: "There is no music worth hearing save only in the last forty years." On Saturday, March 19, the UD Arts Series will host an event showcasing the compositions to which Tinctoris referred -- madrigals. The Cleveland State University Collegium Musicum will be featured at this year's Madrigal Dinner.

While listening to the madrigal pieces, those who attend the Madrigal Dinner will dine on hot punch, Boar's Head whole (recognizable to the modern palate as roast sirloin of beef), Yorkshire pudding, roasted potato, spiced fresh carrots, radiance salad, ravelled bread, and flaming plum pudding.
