UD HOUSING HELPS MAKE
DAYTON MORE "BEAUTIFUL"

DAYTON, Ohio, March 16, 1983 -- The University of Dayton has been awarded the Dayton City Beautiful Council's "Distinguished Achievement Award" for its contribution to neighborhood beautification. UD received one of 75 certificates given by the City to homeowners who demonstrate continued efforts to maintain their properties.

The University's Office of Off-Campus Housing director, Joseph Belle says, "the City housing inspector recommended UD for the award." Quarterly, City Housing Conservation Specialists inspect homes in Dayton neighborhoods. They recognize properties that represent "civic pride."

UD received the award for the property located at 302 Kiefaber Avenue. The University owns 127 housing units off campus.
