DAYTON, Ohio, March 16, 1983 -- The University of Dayton, in cooperation with the City of Dayton, is having a neighborhood clean-up program on Saturday, March 19, 1983 from 10 a.m. until noon. The "clean sweep" will involve over 300 UD students who volunteer their time for this effort.

The "clean sweep" program is organized by the UD Student Association and the Off-Campus Center. UD director of Off-Campus Housing, Joseph Belle, says this semi-annual University clean-up program "demonstrates the UD students concern for their community."
