UD AWARDS 613 DEGREES
AT SUMMER COMMENCEMENT

DAYTON, Ohio, July 26, 1983 ← The University of Dayton will confer degrees upon 613 men and women in summer commencement exercises Sunday, July 31. Ceremonies will begin at 10 a.m. in the UD Arena. This is the third commencement exercise of the 1982-83 academic year for Ohio's largest independent university.

The graduates will receive 174 bachelor's, 424 master's, and 13 educational specialist degrees along with 2 doctoral degrees, one in engineering and one in biology.

The educational specialist degree is an intermediate degree between the master's in education and the doctorate. The program, which combines students, faculty, and administrators of Wright State University and the University of Dayton, is unique to this area. It is designed for school administrators who seek additional training in leadership, institutional change, decision-making, organizational theory, and communication processes.

A special graduation Mass will be celebrated Saturday at 4:30 p.m. in the Immaculate Conception Chapel with a reception following in the John F. Kennedy Memorial Union for the graduates and their families.
