VICE PRESIDENT
TAKES LEAVE

DAYTON, Ohio, August 25, 1983 -- Margaret M. Holland, vice president for student development and dean of students, will take a leave of absence for the current school year, it was announced today by UD President Brother Raymond L. Fitz, S.M. Holland, who came to UD in 1966 as dean of women, was appointed dean of students in 1969 and vice president in 1973. She has served continuously at UD since 1966.

Brother Fitz will not appoint an acting vice president at this time, but will instead assign responsibility for operation of the Student Development programs to the assistants to the vice president and associate deans of students and to the respective department heads within the division. Regular meetings of the directors' group with the president will be held throughout the school year to assure coordination of various staff functions, planning, and programming.
