FORMER UD CHAIRMAN DIES

DAYTON, Ohio, August 31, 1983 -- James M. Ferrigno, former chairman of the University of Dayton Department of Languages, died Sunday, August 28, at the age of 73.

Ferrigno came to UD in August 1963 to serve as chairman of the Department of Languages. He held the position of chairman for eight years. During the 1971-72 academic year he was granted a sabbatical. Ferrigno returned to UD in 1972 and taught for three years before retiring in 1975.

Ferrigno held bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees from Boston University and had received a certificate from the University of Rome.

Ferrigno is survived by his wife Mary and four children. Most recently he was a resident of Cocoa Beach, Florida.
