ART ON THE UD LIBRARY LAWN

DAYTON, Ohio, September 8, 1983 -- On Saturday and Sunday, September 17 and 18, local artists will display and sell their work on the University of Dayton Roesch Library lawn. The UD Library Lawn Artsorama, the oldest outdoor art show in southwest Ohio, will be held from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. each day.

This two-day show will feature fine arts, crafts, music, dance, poetry, mime, and the sale of refreshments. Watercolors, pottery, calligraphy, woodcarving, casted jewelry, and lapidary are some of the art forms to be displayed. A few of the local artists participating are Homer Hacker, Emerick Malogorski and David L. Smith.
