### HOMEcoming FESTIVITIES PLANNED AT UD

DAYTON, Ohio, September 29, 1983 -- It's time for 1983 Homecoming festivities at the University of Dayton. UD alumni and students, as well as the Dayton community, will find many activities in which to participate.

Homecoming week begins Sunday, October 2, with UD's annual International Tea. This year's tea theme is "Windows of the World" and the event will be held in the Kennedy Union Ballroom from 2 to 5 p.m. UD American and international students will share their heritages with a variety of coffees, teas, pastries, artifacts, and costumes. There is an extensive entertainment bill-of-fare. Admission is free.

On Monday, October 3, the Kennedy Union Ballroom will become "Cabaret Parfait," a Parisian night club, from 7 to 10 p.m. Another transformation of the Ballroom will take place on Tuesday, October 4 when the Ballroom becomes "Shanghai Palace," an exotic Chinese Forum from 7 to 10 p.m. On Wednesday, October 5, the public's invited to opening night of the "World Premiere of Queens" in New York. The candidates for this year's Homecoming queen will perform skits in the Kennedy Union Ballroom beginning at 7:30 p.m.

An outdoor marketplace will be the site of bargaining for imported goods on Thursday, October 6. UD students will be able to purchase items from various international vendors of the Dayton community. The "World Market" will be in the Kennedy Union Plaza from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Also on Thursday, an "International Film Festival" will be held. In Boll Theatre at 7 p.m., "Amarcord" (Fond Memories) will be shown, and at 9:30 p.m. "Un Voleur a Paris" (A Thief in Paris) will begin. In Chudd Auditorium "Kwaidan" (A Ghost Story) will be shown at 7:30 p.m. All the movies are subtitled. Admission and popcorn are free.

A "Parade of Nations" will wind its way from the Montgomery County Fairgrounds to the Kennedy Union Plaza on Friday, October 7 at 3 p.m. Then at 7 p.m. a wine and cheese party for UD alumni and friends will be held in the Kennedy Union Torch Lounge.

Saturday's schedule of events begins at 10 a.m. with campus tours for returning alumni and friends. Tours will begin at the Bookstore and will be given until 1 p.m. The UD Flyers meet the Lords of Kenyon at 1:30 p.m. at Welcome Stadium. Halftime festivities will feature the "Pride of Dayton" Marching Band and crowning of the 1983 Homecoming queen. An alumni Hospitality House will follow the game in the UD Arena.

A Homecoming Dinner to honor this year's alumni award winners will be held. The dinner begins at 6:30 p.m. at the Daytonian Hilton. Honorees include Donald M. Knowlan, M.D., a 1951 graduate; Shirley Ann Pohl, a 1957 graduate; John R. Westerheide, a 1947 graduate; Robert Arnzen, a 1951 graduate; Robert L. Bates, a 1967 graduate; Diana R. Dunn, a 1959 and 1963 graduate; and Walter A. DeAnna, a 1962 graduate.

Knowlan, Pohl, and Westerheide are being honored as Distinguished Alumni. Special Achievement Awards are going to Arnzen, Bates, and Dunn. DeAnna will receive a Special Service Award.

Dances will be held at the Downtown Dayton Arcade (for alumni and friends) beginning at 9 p.m. and at Wampler's Ballroom (for UD students) beginning at 10 p.m.

To close out the weekend, Mass will be celebrated in the Immaculate Conception Chapel at 11:30 a.m. on Sunday, October 9. A continental breakfast will follow.
