LEON C. MARTEL FEATURED IN
DISTINGUISHED SPEAKERS SERIES

DAYTON, Ohio, January 12, 1984 -- Dr. Leon C. Martel, internationally known futurist and policy analyst, will discuss George Orwell's 1984 as part of the University of Dayton Distinguished Speakers Series. The theme of the Series this semester is "1984 and Beyond."

Martel will examine Orwell's predictions and assess their accuracy in a presentation entitled "1984, How Near How Far?" at 8 p.m. on Tuesday, January 31, in the Kennedy Union Ballroom.

A captain in the U.S. Naval Reserve, Martel has extensive experience in the fields of political and military intelligence. He was a member of the professional staff of the Hudson Institute, a "think tank," and served as its executive vice president from 1977 to 1980. Prior to that he was a tenured member of the Hofstra University faculty. He has also been in charge of the Russian and East European desk in the Navy's European Intelligence Center and served as an intelligence research analyst in the National Security Agency.
