## LENT EVENT

DAYTON, Ohio, March 15, 1984 -- On Wednesday, March 28, the University of Dayton's Campus Ministry will present the third annual "Lent Event"--a Lenten prayer service--at 8 p.m. in the Immaculate Conception Chapel on the UD Campus.

"This year's Lent Event, entitled 'The Walk to Emmaus,' will be a dramatic representation of the events and story of the disciples' encounter with Jesus on their journey to Emmaus," said Campus Ministry's Sister Laura Leming, F.M.I., Lent Event coordinator.

The 40-minute presentation, which is free and open to the campus community and the public, will feature music, dance, mime, drama, and singing by UD students and Campus Ministry staff.

"The audience will be encouraged to participate -- certainly through prayer and at other times when appropriate," said Leming. "'The Walk to Emmaus' is like Godspell, but on a much smaller scale," she continued.
