HONORED BY SCHOLARSHIP

DAYTON, Ohio, May 8, 1985 -- The Russell Primrose Honors Scholarship Fund is being established at the University of Dayton in recognition of Primrose's service as dean of the School of Engineering and his active support of the University Honors Program. Primrose is stepping down as dean this year and will take a one-year sabbatical before taking on new responsibilities.

"Dean Primrose has served the University well, and I am pleased to recognize his service by establishing this scholarship fund in his name," said University President Brother Raymond L. Fitz, S.M.

Primrose has supported the University Honors Program, which provides academically gifted students an opportunity to take specially designed seminar courses in a variety of disciplines. He helped integrate a systems design seminar, required of all honors students, into the program.

The scholarship will aid engineering students who are accepted into the Honors Program. The first awards will be made in August 1986.

The scholarship has been endowed by \$50,000 in gifts to the Campaign for the University of Dayton.
