DONALD E. LEWIS, PH.D.
1931 - 1985

DAYTON, Ohio, May 10, 1985 -- Donald E. Lewis, Ph.D., professor and chairman of the Department of Electrical Engineering at the University of Dayton, died early on Friday, May 10, following a heart attack. He was 53 years old.

Professor Lewis taught electrical engineering at UD from 1965 until his death. In addition to his teaching assignments on the undergraduate and graduate levels, he conducted sponsored research and consulted in various areas of electrical engineering.

Prior to joining the UD faculty, Professor Lewis was an electronic engineer with the U.S. Air Force at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base. He also taught engineering courses at Ohio State University from 1957 until 1959.

Professor Lewis held three degrees in electrical engineering: a bachelor's degree from the University of Cincinnati (1954), Master of Science from Ohio State University (1957), and a Ph.D. from Ohio State University (1964).

Dr. Lewis is survived by his wife Mary Louise of Centerville and daughter Susan Schnabel of Centerville.

Funeral arrangements are being handled by Westbrook Funeral Home. Visitation will be on Tuesday, May 14, at the Woodland Cemetery Mausoleum Chapel from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. Burial will be at 2 p.m. at the Woodland Cemetery Mausoleum.
